



## **Saint Report** **Parish School of Religion/Private School**

“Another way to express the close connection between Baptism and Confirmation is through the choice of a name. It is appropriate that the baptismal name be used at the time of Confirmation. The name of another saint who offers particular witness to the candidate may be chosen.”

Choosing a Confirmation name is a decision you will want to consider carefully. Throughout your life as a Christian, you will find inspiration and motivation from the example of holy men and women. Names of saints are chosen to serve as patrons and models for those confirmed. Saints show us how to follow our God, how to persevere, how to be holy men and women. They show us how to live the Catholic way of life.

You may have a name in mind, but don't be concerned if you have not chosen a name yet. The saint report is a task designed to help you search more deeply into the lives of people who will be a role model for you.

Your search begins by reading about the lives of saints in books and other sources. After you have read about several saints whose lives bear witness to the kind of life you want to live pray for guidance from the Holy Spirit to help you choose one to be your patron.

Please use the Saint Report format to outline your report. Your report should be:

- 250 words
- 12 point font
- 1 inch margins
- 1.5 or Double Space
- PSR/Private reports should be submitted to the **Parish Office** by November 3, 2025.
